RE: Covid/Face Covering Policy

There have recently been changes in our State's mask mandates. This memo serves to clarify PRTR policy. Based on State guidance for healthcare facilities, which includes Promise Ranch, we will continue to wear our masks indoors with clients and volunteers. If we are outdoors and can be socially distanced, we can allow not wearing a mask. This applies to barn staff, head walkers going out to get horses for sessions, and 1:1 sessions between vaccinated staff and clients.

The official guidance states that people who do not have to wear a mask, even if unvaccinated, include:

People who are 10 years old and younger.

People who cannot medically tolerate a face covering.

However, as much as possible, we do encourage **all** clients to wear a mask, as research shows that people who have no symptoms can spread COVID-19. Wearing a mask helps minimize the spread of the virus.

We will no longer be taking temperatures or recording temperatures in the log books. However, it is recommended that all those who come to PRTR self-screen for symptoms of Covid-19, and if they are feeling sick, do not come on the premises.
